

Senior School Uniform List 2025-2026

Compulsory items	All items from our regular school uniform supplied, <i>Schoolblazer</i> , unless clearly stated
Blazer	To be worn to and from school.
Skirt	Kilt style to be worn to the knee.
Tailored Grey Trousers	Can be worn as an alternative to the skirt.
Blouse	White short sleeved, with school crest. Long sleeved version with school crest available as optional item (available to order from October Half Term).
Jumper	Damson jumper or in Year 11 a Grey cardigan.
Socks	Plain black or white ankle or knee length socks. Trainer socks or sports socks should not be worn. Can be purchased from a high street shop.
Overall - Art / Science	Navy.
Optional uniform	
Tights	Plain black opaque for Years 7 and 8. Sheer black permitted for Years 9 and above, if preferred.
Coat	Girls should wear a blazer to and from school. They may also choose to buy a plain black coat of their choice with no patterns, furry lining, or trims.
Bench Coat	Alternatively, students may wear the BGS sports Bench Coat - Purchased from: nolimitz.co.uk.
Scarves, hats, gloves	A bespoke designed school hat and scarf available from <i>Schoolblazer</i> . Gloves must be plain back.
Hair Scrunchie - Black	Hair bands of any description must be black. Scrunchies and hair ties should be black. No decorative clips.
Cardigan Year 11 only	In Year 11 a Grey cardigan may we worn instead of Damson jumper.
Footwear and bags	
Shoes	All school shoes must be black leather and heels should be flat. Shoes should enclose the foot and remain securely on the foot. They may have a strap around the ankle, a T-bar or be lace-ups. No trainer style shoes allowed.

School bags	Schoolbags for Years 7 & 8 should be bought from <i>Schoolblazer</i> . Other year groups should have bags that are sturdy, plain and dark in colour.
Jewellery, make-up and hair	Please note what is permitted; we do NOT permit any other items
Jewellery	Two simple studs, one ring, one necklace and one bracelet ONLY. Any jewellery must be discreet. No other piercings are allowed. No hoop earrings or ear bars are allowed. Jewellery (including ear studs) must be removed for PE and other lessons. Please only get ears pierced at the start of the summer holidays so studs can be removed for PE in September.
Make-up	Only allowed in Years 9 and above, it must always be discreet and natural.
Hair	Hair must be tidy and of a natural colour. Shoulder length hair must be tied up for PE and other practical lessons.
Nails	We do not permit acrylic nails or nail varnish.
Dance, Drama, Music	
Dance and Drama top	These are optional but should be plain black from a high street shop.
Dance and Drama Leggings	These are optional but should be plain black from high street shop.
Dance Shoes	These are optional Black Jazz Shoes.
Music performance outfit (for performers only)	Black dress or trousers, any style but appropriate for playing a musical instrument in a public performance.
