### Dance

Junior, Senior and Sixth Form 2025-26

The Dance Department offers a variety of dance classes, which aim to develop technique and specialist skills alongside having fun and getting fit. We provide a full timetable of classes offering something for everyone. Lessons in syllabus Ballet, Tap and Modern Theatre Dance are available from Y3 and above. Jazz lessons are available from Y7. Non-syllabus classes include Hip-Hop from Y5 to Y10 and Contemporary from Y7 to Y10 classes. In addition to the RAD Ballet grades we offer Specialist and Beginner Pointe Work as well as Dance Fitness. Depending on demand, next year we may offer a Progressive Technique Ballet class that will help to further develop and strengthen the students' performance through the training of muscle memory, core strength, stability, weight placement and alignment. Ultimately these skills promote improved performance, strength and confidence.

Ballet classes follow the Royal Academy of Dance Syllabus (RAD). Modern Theatre Dance, Tap, Jazz and Contemporary follow those of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance (ISTD). Although pupils can be entered for public examinations and assessments, this is not compulsory and is at the discretion of the teacher.

Before starting Dance lessons, both parents and students should be aware that regular practice is essential for progress to be made and it is important that students attend all of their lessons, arrive promptly and with the correct Dance uniform. Specialist clothing is required for some dance classes and are available for purchase through <u>dancedirect.com</u>. Please see <u>here</u> for a full list of Dance uniform requirements.

### **Instrumental Music**

Junior, Senior and Sixth Form 2025-26

The Music Department offers instrumental lessons on all orchestral instruments - guitar, bass guitar, drum kit, recorder, and piano. All instruments, except the piano, the harp and drum kits, can be hired, initially for a period of one year, when the student's interest and aptitude will be assessed. It is then advisable for parents to buy an instrument for their daughter's use.

Before starting instrumental lessons both parents and students should be aware that daily practice is essential if progress is to be made. For beginners, a 10-minute slot at a set time of day works well and soon becomes part of an instrumentalist's daily routine. Practicing before homework is often a good idea. This gives students a break from academic work and ensures that they are not too tired to make the best use of their time.

All students are encouraged to participate in at least one of the many co-curricular groups available.

During the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms there are opportunities for entry to external examinations with the Associated Board of the Royal School of Music (ABRSM), Trinity Guildhall and London College of Music (LCM) exam boards. Students may also enter for the Bedfordshire Festival of Music, Speech and Drama in the Spring Term.

Students will receive varying numbers of lessons depending on term length. Any adjustments to fees will be made at the end of the Summer Term.

Please also note that at least 48 hours' notice of cancellation for anticipated absence must be provided to the School in order to prevent charges being incurred. Before starting singing lessons, parents and students alike should be aware that daily practice is essential if progress is to be made. For beginners, a 10-minute slot at a set time of day works well and soon becomes part of a singer's daily routine. Practicing before homework is often a good idea. This gives students a break from academic work and ensures that they are not too tired to make the best use of their time.

During the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms there are opportunities for entry to external examinations with the Associated Board of the Royal School of Music (ABRSM), Trinity Guildhall and London College of Music (LCM) exam boards. ### Speech & Drama

Speech and Drama is taught by qualified specialists in small groups or on an individual basis during lunchtimes or on a rotational timetable. Each lesson lasts for half an hour and the students are taught in groups according to age.

During the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms there are opportunities for entry to external examinations with the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art (LAMDA). Students may also enter for the Bedfordshire Festival of Music, Speech and Drama in the Spring Term, in a wide range of classes e.g. verse speaking, verse duets, group poem, prepared reading and prose duets. Bedford Girls' School enjoys an unrivalled success at this annual event.

Improve standards of communication through the spoken word.

Foster an appreciation and love of literature, poetry and drama.

Develop performance skills.

Correct speech faults.

Develop vocal skills including vocal projection, modulation and clarity of diction.

Develop public speaking skills.

Unlock imagination and creative thinking.

Build self-confidence and self-esteem.
